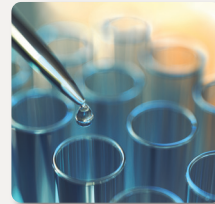

The scholarships cover tuition fee waivers for the entire duration of the programme. The amount reduced from the tuition fee is reflected in the student invoice. The scholarship recipients need to meet the following requirements:

- Maintain status as an active, registered student.
- Maintain a CGPA not lower than 3.00.
- Fulfil all specific requirements related to the involvement in student activities.
- No outstanding payments.
- Not subject to any disciplinary investigation or action.
