- Attended Research Methodology course prior to the presentation in the research proposal defence committee.
- Passed the Research Proposal stage within a stipulated duration.

Education Financing – i Bank Rakyat

- Bank Rakyat offers Education Financing-i for those who plan to further their studies in postgraduate programmes offered by KPJU.

Eligibility Criteria for Applicants

Applicants applying for the financing facilities are required to fulfil the following criteria: -

- Malaysian Citizen.
- Minimum age of 18 years old and maximum age of 60 years old at the end of the financing tenure.
- Minimum monthly income of RM2,000.
- Applicant from student itself or immediate family member with fixed income.

Features of Education Financing-i Facility

- Financing up to RM250,000.
- Tenure up to 20 years (including grace period).
- Grace period based on the duration of studies OR a maximum four (4) years; whichever is shorter.
- Takaful coverage is optional.
- Financing is disbursed per semester and paid directly to KPJU.

Affin Islamic Education Financing-i

KPJU has a mutual agreement with Affin Islamic Bank to provide an alternative source of financing for students. This Education Financing is available for students pursuing studies in higher education or professional courses worldwide. Applications are open to all Foundation, Diploma, Bachelor and Postgraduate programmes at KPJU.

General guidelines;

- Aged 18 to 45 years old.
- Applicable to new and existing full-time and part-time students.
- Applicable to all levels of programme levels.
- Must have 2 co-applicants (age 21 and over) from immediate family members.
- Minimum annual income of RM 24,000. However, at least one of the joint applicants must have an annual income of RM36,000.

High financing up to RM 400,000 is available. (Note: A maximum financing amount of RM600,000 is eligible for Medical student only) The repayment period is between 5 and 15 years and the student will need to pay the financing profit during the study period. Full monthly instalment will only be effective upon completion of study.
